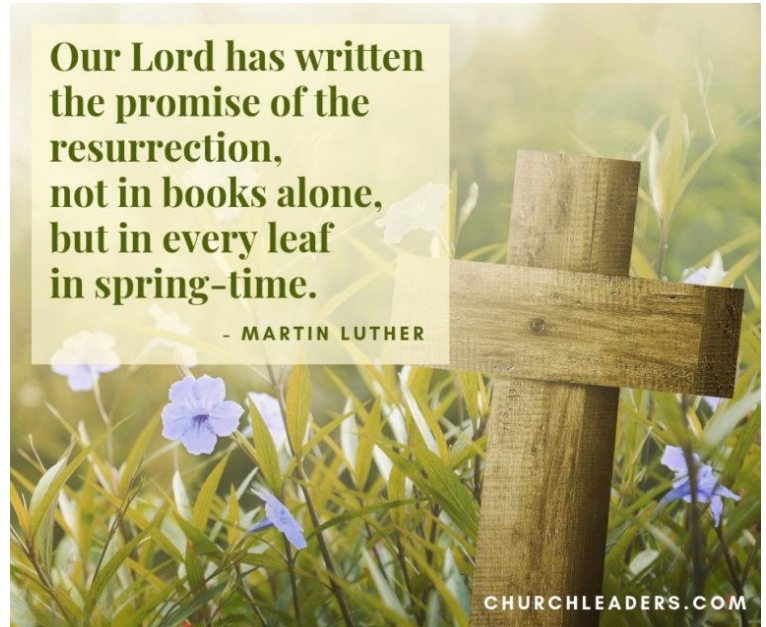
Re-enrollment Packets

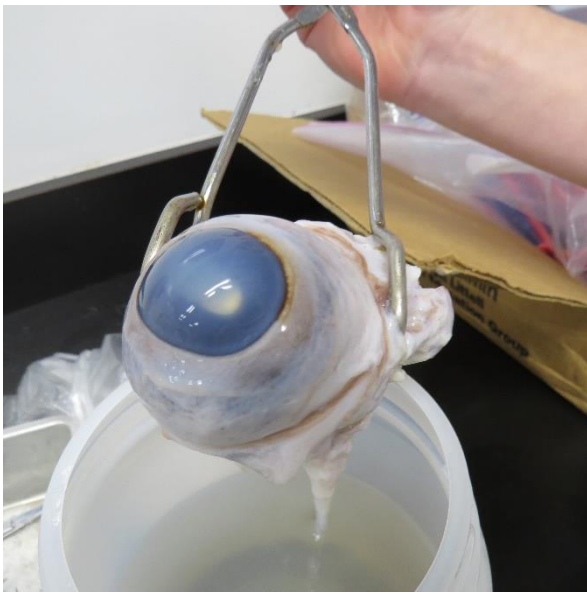
Classroom News:
