## ESAs: How to Apply

The application process is in development now with plans to begin taking applications during the month of May, but a specific day has not yet been announced. Details regarding the application process will be provided later this month to help families prepare to apply. Applications will be due on June 30, 2023, for the 2023-2024 school year. Applications are valid for one year; a family must apply annually to remain eligible for the program. It is the responsibility of the family to apply, so sign up for notifications on the Iowa Department of Education Website ([educateiowa.gov](http://educateiowa.gov)) under Education Savings Accounts and keep watching for developments.
